## Improving equity in maternity care: lessons from the Lambeth Early Action Partnership (LEAP)


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

The LEAP Midwifery Continuity of Care (MCoC) team has provided personalised maternity care for 500+ births to ethnically diverse women living in areas of high deprivation in Lambeth, south London.

MCoC provides: a named midwife; longer and more frequent appointments than traditional care; community-based; holistic support via other LEAP services.

89% of women receiving care live in areas of greatest deprivation\*





This model of care, in a small but significant way, illustrates the positive impact that 'gold standard' maternity care can make for women most at risk of worse outcomes
